Background

Tate Liverpool and University of Liverpool work in partnership to provide staff and students with a range of exclusive benefits and exciting opportunities to engage with the cultural sector; including free tickets to paying exhibitions; discounts in our Café and Shop, and exclusive events and competitions.

We're looking for two Student Ambassadors to promote these benefits and help encourage visits to exhibitions and events at Tate galleries using word-of-mouth and social media.

Successful applicants will join Tate Liverpool at an exciting time in the gallery's history, as the building undergoes a period of transformation. From October 2023, Tate Liverpool will be temporarily closed, due to the building redevelopment. During this time, Tate Liverpool will partner with the Royal Institute of National Architects (RIBA). Tate Liverpool + RIBA North will see all Tate Liverpool operations (including exhibitions, the café and shop) housed within RIBA North, located on Mann Island, just a five-minute walk from our current home.

- The role is expected to last November 2023 – August 2024.

- Attending an introductory welcome session at Tate Liverpool + RIBA North.
- Representing Tate Liverpool at University events including Welcome Fairs, Open Days and other events online and/or in-person.
- Promoting university partnership benefits to other students using social media and other appropriate channels.
- Generating ideas - Student Ambassadors are encouraged to share thoughts their ideas as to what they'd like to get out of the role, and we will always listen to suggestions.
