## Breakout room 2: Assessing remote labs

## Changes to delivery of labs include:

- Filming experiments and providing data for analysis with some face-to-face but much reduced due to social distancing requirements
- Combination of in person labs and remote with previously recorded data
- Small selection of simple experiments to carry out at home with an experimental kit provided, e.g. scales, thermometer, tape measure etc.
- Module previously only half electronics now entirely electronics and students will receive a picoscope, breadboard and components for the year

## Previous assessment methods and proposed changes:

- 100% assessment of log books will now be OneNote books locked at the end of a session
- Assessment emphasis on analysis rather than carrying out an experiment
- Lab modules previously assessed on separate components will be assessed on an overarching project
- Labs previously checked using timestamps by when students should have reached a certain point will not be easily reproduced remotely.
