

# SCHEDULE OF FEES 2018-19

### 1. PROGRAMME FEES

The fees for programmes of study prescribed in section 1 are consolidated to include the appropriate sessional charge for tuition, registration, examination and graduation. Unless otherwise indicated, the programme fees do not cover the cost of field trips, sundries or consumables (e.g. research support fees) which may be payable separately, as appropriate.

All programme fees are payable sessionally in advance, or as prescribed in the 2017-18 Payment Policy. Where a student, for whatever reason, leaves their programme during the session, the University will re-calculate the amount of fee to be charged, based upon the date the University is formally informed of the change in registration, in accordance with the 2017-18 Payment Policy. In such an event, a student will have no claim to a refund of fees charged for the period they were registered during that session.

## 1.1.3 General Student Fees

Students registered on taught programmes of study with no qualification aim will be charged the appropriate full-time fee, as prescribed in section 1. Students registered part-time will be charged pro rata to the full-time fee.

Visiting postgraduate research students<sup>1</sup> programme fee is set at two levels. The first level will relate to all Visiting Scholars who request a programme without supervision. The second level will apply to students who are looking to participate on a programme which includes supervision.

**Visiting Scholars Programme: Non-Supervisory** - No charge for the first three months. Following this period, a fee of £100 per month will be charged at the commencement of the visit.

**Visiting Scholars Programme: Supervisory** – Programme fees charged will be at the standard Home, EU or non-EU fee, as applicable, calculated on a monthly basis for the period of study, charged at the commencement of the study period.
