From the School of Arts (level 2) separate periodic reviews will be undertaken on the following:

From the School of Histories, Languages and Cultures (level 2) separate periodic reviews will be undertaken on the following:

From the School of Law and Social Justice (level 2) separate periodic reviews will be undertaken on the following:

FACULTY OF SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING

The School of Engineering has no level 1 departments, therefore periodic review will be undertaken at the following level:

From the School of Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Computer Science (level 2) separate periodic reviews will be undertaken on the following:

- Computer Science (level 1)
- Electrical Engineering and Electronics (level 1)

From the School of Physical Sciences (level 2) separate periodic reviews will be undertaken on the following:

- Chemistry (level 1)
- Mathematical Sciences (level 1)
- Physics (level 1)

From the School of Environmental Sciences (level 2):

- Earth, Ocean and Ecological Sciences (level 1)
- Geography and Planning (level 1)

If a Faculty or Level 2 School wishes to conduct periodic review at a level which is different from that detailed above, it must present a proposal for this to the PVC for Education for approval. Any such proposal should explain matters such as:

- the logistics for undertaking and managing the periodic review;
- how the meetings will be managed, such as in terms of Chair responsibilities, minute taking, use of parallel meetings;
- how many external panel members will be required and how subject specific aspects will be addressed in the review;
- how the review, conducted at the proposed level, will meet the requirements of the periodic review, including programme revalidation, as detailed in the periodic review guidelines and appendices.

The above list is not exhaustive and additional information may be required or relevant depending on the reason for the proposal. Any such proposal should be made with sufficient time to allow the periodic review schedule to be reviewed and revised and to prepare for the periodic review at the level agreed.
