Process for consideration of reports from Professional Statutory and Regulatory Bodies (PSRB)

- The Faculty Academic Quality and Standards Committees (FAQSC) in the Faculties
 of Health and Life Sciences and Science and Engineering, and the Faculty Education,
 Enhancement and Assurance Committee (FEEAC) in the Faculty of Humanities and
 Social Sciences should receive a schedule of PSRB activity at the beginning of each
 academic year.
- FAQSC/FEEAC should receive the outcomes/reports of PSRB activity (i.e. accreditation, recognition, inspection visits) for appropriate discussion and approval of action plans.
- FAQSC/FEEAC should monitor any conditions and recommendations from PSRB activity and ensure that any University action has been signed off.
- FAQSC/FEEAC shall submit to the University AQSC a summary of any PSRB report with outcomes (i.e. good practice/conditions) highlighted and confirmation that appropriate action is taking place.
- Updates on conditions and confirmation that these have been met should be monitored and reported via FAQSC/FEEAC to the University AQSC.
- Programme teams will detail any action within their Single Action Plan (which can be a copy of the response to the PSRB appended to the Single Action Plan if appropriate).
- A summary of activity will be included as part of the Annual Report to Senate and Council.
